**Structure and Duration of the Cours:** The Course is for a limited number of participants (max 40) and consists of 2 Residential Modules (total duration, 43 hours)

**CME:** Participation in the 2 Residential Modules of the Course gives the opportunity to obtain 46.9 CME credits.
